

Creating your *JAE* profile:

To register with the *Journal of Agricultural Education*, please visit <https://jae-online.org/index.php/jae/user/register>.

Profile:

Please enter your name exactly as you wish it to appear in any publications. The information used in the “How to Cite” textbox on an article’s webpage is pulled exclusively from the “*Given Name*” and “*Family Name*” fields.

Given Name:

1. This is also known as your first name. (e.g., Brian).
2. If you would like your middle name or middle initial to appear in publications, please include it in this textbox (e.g., Brian E.).

Family Name:

1. This is typically your last name (e.g., Myers)
2. Names are alphabetized by the data in this textbox.

Affiliation: Enter the name of your institution/university

Country: Select your country of residence from the drop-down menu.

Login:

Email: All communications from the *Journal of Agricultural Education* will be sent to this email.

Username: Create a unique username.

Password: The password must be at least 12 characters.

Checkboxes:

1. Select “Yes” if you agree to have your data collected and stored according to the privacy statement.
2. Select “Yes” if you would like to be notified of new publications and announcements.
3. Select “Yes” if you would like to be contacted with requests to review submissions to this journal.
